Purpose:

Applicant must:

- have completed two semesters (or equivalent, e.g. quarters or classes or sessions) of academic work in the last 18 months — grades for these classes must be available to the Scholarship Committee
- not have received more than two U.S.S. GOLDSBOROUGH Association (USSGA) scholarships toward the same degree, and be a
- Current member of the U.S.S. GOLDSBOROUGH DDG-20 ASSOCIATION (form for USSGA membership can be filed with the scholarship application).

This award is offered in addition to any other educational support.

- Education goals
- Education history
- Transcripts
- Statement of objectives
- Community service
